If we receive a grant from the Lilly foundation, Pastor Randy would like to learn more about how our Christian faith has and is currently being passed from one generation to the next.

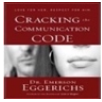
*Your support is needed!* The Lilly foundation wants to see congregational support for their pastor's sabbatical. Here are a few important details:
