A Note from your TRC Deacons: Throughout 2018 we had been reporting to you of Trinity's deficit financial situation which at the end of November had our expenses exceeding our income by \$14,390.00. We prayed the Lord would resolve this situation. Thru His actions and your great generosity, the month of December provided a general fund income of \$26,471.00 which was about double our average monthly giving and much greater than anyone had anticipated. This overwhelming response to our financial appeals allowed us to closeout the 2018 financials with a deficit of only \$1,786.00, which puts us in a solid financial position for the start of 2019. We offer our prayers of thanksgiving for His gifts and gratitude to you for your continuing support for Trinity's ministry.
