Greear.** A little about J.D. first - age 27 started his ministry as a pastor of a 40 yr. old church that has grown over the years to a mega church in Raleigh-Durham, North Carolina. J.D. said that his messages aren't intended just to show people how to live better lives, but to leave people in awe of God's amazing love.

**INTRODUCTION to Study:** What's the most important priority in your life? In your family? In your church? If you're a follower of Jesus, the answer to all of these questions should be the same: the gospel of Jesus Christ. The gospel, you see, is more than simply the entry rite into Christianity. It's not just the ABCs of the Christian life; it's the entire alphabet. It's not just the diving board off which we jump into the pool of Christianity; it's the whole pool.
