J.D. said that his messages aren't intended just to show people how to live better lives, but to leave people in awe of God's amazing love.

INTRODUCTION to Study: What's the most important priority in your life? In your family? In your church? If you're a follower of Jesus, the answer to all of these questions should be the same: the gospel of Jesus Christ. The gospel, you see, is more than simply the entry rite into Christianity. It's not just the ABCs of the Christian life; it's the entire alphabet. It's not just the diving board off which we jump into the pool of Christianity; it's the whole pool. Paul said that the gospel was the only message worth proclaiming to the world. (1 Corinthians 15:3) It was the one priority his life was about. What about you?

CHAPTERS: Gospel Above All, Gospel Change, Gospel Mission, Gospel Evangelism, Gospel Grace, Gospel Community, Gospel Unity, Gospel Victory. The goal of this Bible study is to help you see the unique glory of God revealed through the grace of the gospel. Once the message becomes above all in your life, your world will never be the same.
