Hello to all you Beautiful Souls!

Beautiful Soul Miniseries would like to extend a warm welcome to everyone at Trinity to come and see all we do in walking beside the dear souls God places on our path.

Our theme verse:

Proverbs 3:27: Do not withhold good from those to whom it is due, when it is in the power of your hand to do so.

Our motto:

Walking beside the beautiful, hurting soul in love.

We would also like to joyfully offer the opportunity to anyone who would like to come and volunteer.

Here are a few of our programs that we always need volunteers to help.

Our BSM Blessings Storehouse feeds about 250 -300 souls a month; that's averaging between 40-50 families. We always need help stocking our shelves with food, paper products, toiletries, and much more. On the 4th Monday of every month, we have a food truck that comes at 12:30pm. The truck/trailer needs unloading and then stocking the shelves in the storehouse. Each week, the Blessings Storehouse needs to be reorganized and kept clean and tidy.

Our BSM Ladies Boutique receives many donations of clothing and household items weekly. We only accept the best of the best. There is lots of sorting, tagging items, hanging up clothes, keeping everything organized by size and color. It is a constant weekly need. We have happily given away 100's of 1000's of items.

Everything in the Blessings Storehouse is free to our clients.

In the Ladies Boutique, our clients receive a \$25 voucher each month to spend on whatever their need may be.

Our Whispers of Hope Card program sends out encouraging cards 4 times a year locally, in the USA and world wide to missionaries and military and churches. We have volunteers meeting every 3rd Tuesday of the month 1-3pm. The cards are designed by a few staff members. Then the volunteers cut & fold cards, stuff & seal the envelopes, place on stamps and address labels. It's a fun time of fellowship! Snacks and water are always provided.

Our clients come to us from all over. Many are sent to us from other churches, organizations, homeless shelters, Ottawa county Human Services, social workers, and word of mouth from the families we walk beside.

Church Servants Needed for Strategy of Summer Outdoor Worship Services

Note: The Consistory will continue to explore implementing the strategy of summer outdoor worship services as another way of “Seeking, Teaching, Growing, and Serving Our Neighbors so they join as Christ Followers” only if there are the “servants” we need to do this ministry with a standard of excellence. What follows is our best estimation at this time of how many “church servants” we will need every Sunday to proceed with this ministry.

Set Up/Take Down Team (3-5 people before 8 AM and after Worship)

- Stage
- Chairs (if chairs are being provided)
- Sound System with Mixer, Speakers & Microphones positioned in right places
- FM Transmitter
- Livestream equipment and computers, Camera set-up
- Other?

Audio/Visual Team (2-3 people willing to be trained)

- Testing all microphones and speaker sound before 9 AM for instruments
- Setting up and Take down of Livestream (ethernet cable needs to be set up)
- Testing computer feed to livestream
- During worship service, monitor sound and livestream at all times
- Other?

Hospitality Team (3-5 people)

- Make coffee early and put into individual coffee cups
- Deliver coffee, refreshments (donuts?), and a warm welcome to each car
- Distribute Sunday paper and any other resources as needed
- Return to cars to pick up trash to place in garbage
- Other?

Promotion/Outreach Team (3-5 people)

- Responsible for signage on Ferry Street to promote and welcome guests
- Responsible for signage around Tri-Cities area to promote outdoor worship
- Print and Distribute Invitations to the surrounding neighborhood (including homes for the elderly to the South on Ferry) and for Trinity members to hand out as well wherever they live.
- Other?
